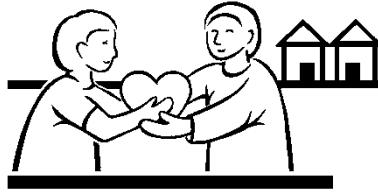

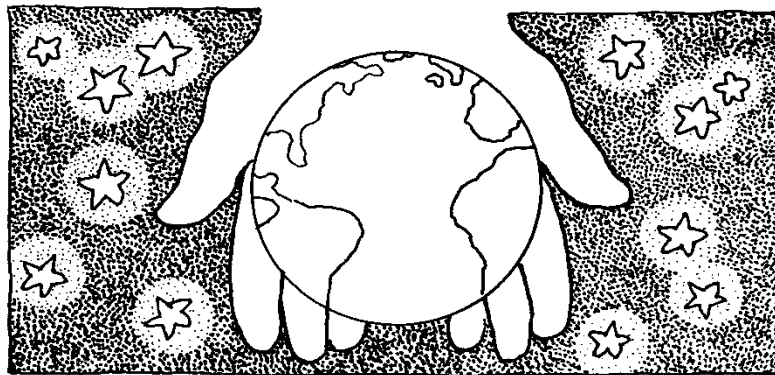
It takes place the 3rd Weekend of every month!

Would you like to help out? by sorting groceries on the 3rd Sunday? Please contact Pat Arand, Outreach at 378-4196.

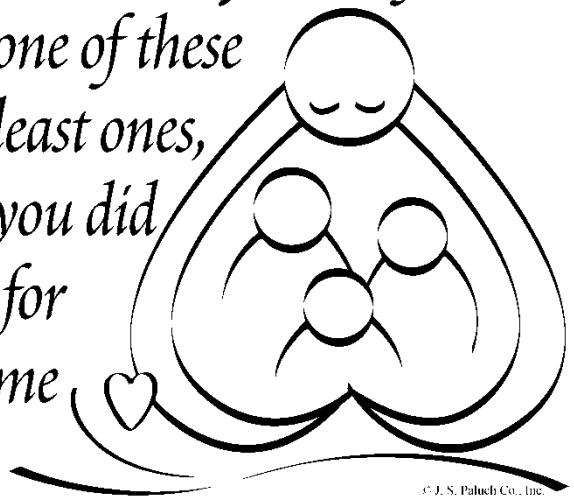
